Dear Parents, Carers and Children

Once again, we have been busy working in school all week this week. We now have a total of 77 children coming to school at some stage of the week working in small groups of no bigger than 10 in Hopscotch-Y3 and 8 for the older children. Everyone is being super-sensible and following the new rules which have been put in place. It is making us all feel a little strange but I am seeing lots of smiley faces as I walk around (at a distance!) and am hearing lots of chatter between the children.

This week we have been working on sending out work packs for children to complete at home. We are really aware that children at home could be at a real disadvantage if they are not able to come into school, especially where other children are being directly taught by class teachers in very small groups in school. We are incredibly grateful that so many have you have been following and sharing the activities that we have set up to now but hope that, through the work packs, we can continue to deliver a little more 'education' to those children still at home. From now until the end of summer term, we will deliver new work and will pick up previous work, on a Friday. Please can I remind everyone who would like to access free school meal vouchers for the summer holidays (total of £90 per child), as announced by the Prime Minister on Tuesday, you MUST be eligible for free school meals for financial reasons. Children ONLY on universal free school meals (Reception-Y2) will NOT receive them. There were changes made to free school meals eligibility during the lockdown period which means that you may be entitled now even if you weren't before.
