Further Details for Dropping off and Picking up

While you are waiting, please stay as close to the wall as you can so that children do not need to walk in the road to pass you.

Wait on the dots outside each gate, or socially-distanced (2m apart). Please do not send children directly into school, or call children out, this must be done by a member of staff.

Please do not stay in groups outside gates or along Cambridge Street, blocking the way (2m) for other parents and children.

Parents dropping children off at Hopscotch, Nursery and Reception must enter the playground via the car park gate or Friars Lane gate. **Please DO NOT use the KS1 gate.**

Please try not to arrive before your allocated time, unless you are dropping off different children at different times.

Parents dropping children off in Y1 (Parrots) and Y2 (Giraffes), please wait away from the gate; Parrots along the school building, Giraffes near the electricity sub-station. Please hand over at the gate.
