Dear Parents, Carers and Children

We have had a very busy week in school this week. Some of the children have been doing assessments and teachers have been working closely with children to see how they are getting on. We are very pleased with the progress they have made this term.

Barrow has seen an increase in numbers of infection this week. Please ensure that adults and children are sticking to the Tier 2 rules of social distancing; no social mixing indoors and sticking to the rule of 6, with social distancing, outdoors. Closure of a bubble in school at any time from now until the end of term will mean a period of isolation through Christmas Day.

There have also been a couple of concerns raised to me this week.

Some parents are feeling anxious about the lack of social distancing and wearing of masks around the school gates. Please keep to the wall, keeping 2m distance between yourself and the next person.

The other concern relates, once again, to cars around the KS1 gate, the staff car park and along Cambridge Street.

Please note: The staff car park is for staff only **at all times**;

Parents are asked not to stop in the car park, on zigzag lines, outside the Co-op funeral service garages or on the pavement in front of the car park gates; Parents are asked not to turn around in the KS1 gate area;

Parents are asked to drive VERY slowly as children may be around.

I wrote a few weeks ago about asking the council if we could block the road. This, unfortunately, is not possible. We are, therefore, asking drivers to drive with due care and attention for EVERYBODY'S children as they drive along Cambridge Street.

Supermarket vouchers have been sent to families of all children entitled to free school meals due to financial reasons; early years pupil premium and 2 year old funding. Please access them before next Wednesday so that we can help with any problems. Food boxes can still be ordered for those families who need them.
